- 1. The learned senior advocate for the applicant has tendered the compilation of documents. The same is taken on record.
- 2. According to the prosecution, the complainant sat in the car of the applicant near the P.W.D. Office. The applicant then on the way to his residential quarter drove the car towards HDFC bank. It is alleged that the incriminating conversation between the applicant and the complainant took place while they were traveling in the car towards HDFC Bank. The learned senior advocate for the applicant submits that the application was made to the HDFC Bank for providing CCTV footage dated 09.12.2024. In response to the said application, the Bank has informed that considering the confidentiality norms, they will not be able to
