**O R D E R**

1. The Pharmacy Council of India – PCI has moved an application seeking modification in the time schedule that has been laid down by this Court in its decision in Civil Appeal No.9048 of 2012 – “*Parshavanath Charitable Trust & Ors. Vs. All India Council for Tech. Edu & Ors.*” vide judgment dated 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2012.
2. By the said judgment, the Court fixed the time schedule within which the process for grant of approval to institutions as well as admission to various professional courses under the aegis of the All India Council for Technical Education was to be undertaken and

completed. In the application, it has been stated that insofar as pharmacy courses are concerned, the last date for granting or refusing the approval by the concerned University/State Government was 15<sup>th</sup> of May of the relevant academic year. The said time schedule came into force from Academic Session 2012-2013.

3. In the present application, it has been stated that on various occasions, the PCI was required to approach this Court with a request to extend the aforesaid timelines in view of various difficulties. In the 119<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Central Council of the PCI, it was resolved that a request be made for modifying the timeline for the annual approval process that is undertaken by the PCI. As per the proposed time schedule, the Academic Session is to commence from 1<sup>st</sup> August and the last date for admitting students would be 15<sup>th</sup> August. A one month extension period is proposed to be kept for the PCI to enable it to utilise this period in case of any unforeseen circumstances for completing the requisite process.
4. We have heard Mr. Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General of India. We have also perused the application alongwith the relevant Minutes of the 119<sup>th</sup> Central Council of PCI meeting wherein the proposed modified schedule has been deliberated upon.

5. Considering the various technical issues encountered by the PCI while considering the request for grant of approval either to existing institutions that intend to introduce additional courses as well as applications for starting new institutions, we are inclined to accept the request made on behalf of the Central Council of the PCI. This would ensure streamlining the entire process and would enable all stakeholders to take timely steps in the matter. The time schedule as proposed by the Central Council is reproduced hereunder:-

1st round of counseling/admission for allotment of seats	30th June
2nd round of counseling for allotment of seats	10th July
Last round of counseling for allotment of seats	
Last date for admitting candidates in seats other than allotted above	30th July  However, any number of rounds for counselling could be conducted depending on local requirements, but all the rounds shall be completed before 30th July
Commencement of academic session	August 1
Last date up to which students can be admitted against vacancies	August 15

Furthermore, it was decided that a one-month extension period would be kept for the PCI. In ease of unforeseen circumstances, this extension may be utilized; however, the Council will inform all stakeholders well in advance.

6. Accordingly, the aforesaid time schedule is accepted in modification of the time schedule that was prescribed in *Parshavanath Charitable*

*Trust & Ors. (supra)*. The same shall be effective from Academic Session 2026-2027.

7. The Miscellaneous Application is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
